Update: Nighttime Closure of Eastbound State Road (SR) 836 for Removal of the Milam Dairy Road Bridge

MIAMI — The closure of all eastbound lanes on SR 836/Dolphin Expressway will resume on Sunday, December 4 through Friday, December 23 (excluding Saturdays) between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. All traffic will be detoured to southbound SR 826 to allow for the removal of the Milam Dairy Road Bridge. The ramps from southbound and northbound SR 826 to eastbound SR 836 will also be closed during this time period. Double westbound lane closures on SR 836 will also be necessary at times between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. from NW 72 Avenue to SR 826.

Eastbound drivers on SR 836 will be guided:

- South on SR 826
- Exit West Flagler Street and turn east
- North on NW 72 Avenue to access eastbound SR 836

Northbound drivers on SR 826 heading eastbound on SR 836 can:

- Exit at West Flagler Street and turn east
- North on NW 72 Avenue to access eastbound SR 836

Southbound drivers on SR 826 heading eastbound on SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street and turn east
- South on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- East on NW 12 Street
- South on NW 72 Avenue to access eastbound SR 836

The closures will allow the contractor to remove portions of the Milam Dairy Road Bridge over the eastbound SR 836 lanes.
